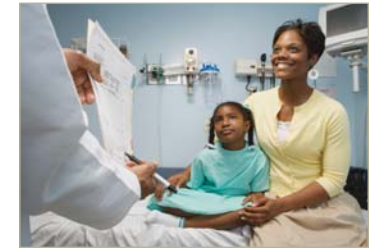

Family Practice physicians treat all ages.

The Family Practice physicians on staff at Oaklawn Hospital are specialists in family medicine. That means they can treat the entire family, from conception and birth right on through adolescence and teens, and continuing on through adulthood and old age. In metropolitan areas, large populations can support physicians who specialize in certain age groups. In smaller communities, the Family Practice physician (FPP) sees the entire family – meaning all ages; and they see all ages every single day. Most of our Family physicians estimate nearly half of their office visits are with children under the age of 18. Additionally, they stay current in the pediatrics field by taking continuing education credits and keeping up with the latest journal studies.

Benefits to knowing patient’s and family’s history.

A benefit of having a Family Practice physician is that he/she is personally aware of your medical history. The FPP does not have to rely on interpreting another physician’s notes, and there’s no need to find another doctor as the patient grows older. The doctor, in many instances, has known the patient from birth, and is very attuned to the patient’s needs. In addition, in many instances the FPP also serves as physician to the other members of the family, so they know the family dynamics, the illnesses and infections that may be affecting the parents and the ramifications that could have for the children in the home.

Good relationships with pediatric specialists.

Oaklawn has over 15 FPPs on active medical staff who, collectively, have cared for thousands and thousands of children, and it’s not unusual for them to confer on certain cases. For special cases, Oaklawn physicians have developed close relationships with some of the area’s finest pediatric specialists at medical centers in both Ann Arbor and Kalamazoo. Says one veteran FPP, “I’ve been treating infants and children for over 20 years and can’t remember ever referring a child to a general pediatrician, but there have been many occasions that I’ve sent them to a pediatric cardiologist, surgeon, gastroenterologist, neurologist, or neonatologist.”
