**Careline Home Monitoring:** This is a personal emergency response system that links the caller to assistance 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

The monitoring unit is a specially designed speaker phone that only requires a modular phone jack.

**Telehealth:** Advanced technology allows HomeCare to track patient health conditions and vital signs through an at-home monitoring system. This TeleHealth technology can monitor health status based on multiple measurements, including blood pressure, pulse/oxygen levels, weight, heart rate and more.
