TIMELINES

Day One



- Fan Out Meeting
 - morning
- Crisis Intervention
 - Individual and Group
- Class Room Presentations
- Operational Debriefing
 - end of day
- K-4th grade (if needed)
 - Defusing Activities for directly exposed

Day Two



- Crisis Intervention
 - (Individual and Group)
- Complete Classroom Presentations
- Parent/Community Meeting

Day Three

- Debriefing Most Exposed (Defusing Young Children)
- Crisis Interventions as needed
- Brief am/pm Crisis Team Meeting
 - Role Assignments
 - Brief Check
 - What each has been least prepared for?
 - What is needed to help each member get through the day?

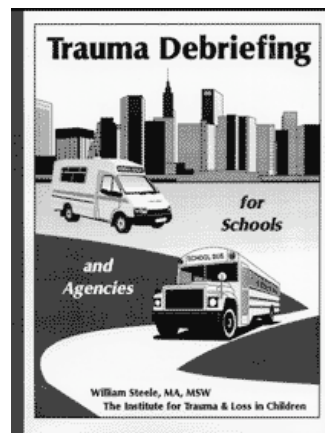
Day Four/Five

- Operational Debriefing with All Staff
 - (Friday afternoons not great but do if necessary)
- Debriefing Crisis Team
 - (See model -Focus on Team/System issues)



End of Second Week

- Formal Debriefing
 - Focus on Individual Experience



Fourth/Fifth Week

- Revisit original Debriefing participants
- CHOICE:
 - Formal Debriefing in a Group
 - OR
 - Crisis Intervention
 - Or
 - No Need for further help
