Richard Berman is the President of Berman and Company, a Washington, D.C.-based public affairs firm specializing in strategic research, communications and creative advertising.

Berman's career specializing in labor and employment law began at Bethlehem Steel. He also served as labor counsel at the Dana Corporation before joining the U.S. Chamber of Commerce as Director of Labor Law. Berman was also employed as an Executive Vice President for the Pillsbury Corporation.

In 2005, Berman created the Center for Union Facts, a nonprofit organization that educates the public about today's union leadership. In 2007, Berman was credited by *Investor's Business Daily* as "leading the fight against card check". The website, www.unionfacts.com, features more than 18 million datapoints of information about how union members' dues are spent. Another website, www.TeachersUnionsExposed.com, provides information about how teachers unions have blocked education reform.

Berman has managed major, multiple industry coalitions dedicated to changing the debate on high profile issues including the minimum wage, the national debt and healthcare reform.
