Subpart L (g) Fire Protection-Portable Fire Suppression Equipment "Training and education states that: (1) Where the employer has provided an educational program to familiarize use in the workplace, the employer shall also provide an educational program to familiarize employees with the general principles of fire extinguisher use and the hazards involved with the incipient stage firefighting. (2) The employer shall provide the education required in paragraph (g) (1) of this section upon initial employment and at least annually thereafter."
