Studding instructions for 24"/61cm wide tracks

Some snowmobiles with tracks wider than 16"/41cm have studding recommendations. Some are not automatically provided in our application guide because Woody's does not have a template that will fit the width of these tracks. It is necessary that you contact our Technical Assistance Department for instructions.

BEAR-TEMP/The BearCat Template has a pattern to create a stud pattern on a 20" x 156"/50cm x 396cm 2.52 pitch track. Use the pattern on this template with 2.52 pitch tracks.

BCTS-TEMP/ he 154"/391cm BearCat Template has a pattern to create 108 single on a 20" x 154"/50cm x 391cm 2.86 pitch single ply tracks.

The application guide will let you know if either of these templates can be used to stud your wide track sled.

These sleds have tracks that are 24"/61cm wide. We do recommend studding these tracks. It is necessary to call our tech line for instructions about choosing a stud quantity and how to create the pattern for installing studs. Ask about the correct runner to balance with the stud quantity chosen.

If you are looking for runner replacement part numbers, Woody's does provide runner replacement recommendations for zero quantity studs in this application.

<u>Woody's Application Guide</u> will provide all three riding style runner part numbers in addition to the number of studs recommended. Choose the runner that corresponds with the number of studs you have installed.
